Solo Folk Song Competition



1. Only 2 entries per College/University Department(s) are allowed.
2. Folk song in Punjabi, Haryanvi or Rajasthani can be presented under this category.
3. Vulgar or inappropriate lyrics are strictly prohibited.
4. The duration of performance will be 3 to 5 minutes.
5. The number of accompanists will not be more than 3.




Creative Nail Art Competition



1. Only 2 entries per College/University Department(s) are allowed.
2. Participants will be given 45 minutes to complete their art work.
3. Only nail paints, nail art pens, stones, stickers, brushes etc. may be used.
4. Participants must bring their own material.
5. The design should be creative and innovative.
6. The nail art should spread a positive and informative message.
7. No offensive, vulgar or misleading content is allowed.
8. Participants will be judged on creativity, neatness, colour combination and message clarity.



Mehandi Competition



1. Only 2 entries per College/University Department(s) are allowed.
2. Participants will be given 1 hour to complete their Mehandi design.
3. Use of hand print, any kind of mould and any kind of decorative material is not allowed.
4. Participants must bring own Mehandi and other material required for it.
5. Participant has to apply Mehandi on palm side of one hand of another person, not on own hand.
6. Participants will be judged on originality, creativity and neatness with aesthetic sense.

Note: Participants must bring their College Identity Card at the time of reporting at Venue.
