In the beginning, the college had intake of 100 seats, but moving on the path of success, at present college is having intake of 200 seats. Let's throw light on the specific features of the college.

1. B.Ed. admissions of 200 seats for the session 2024-25 have been successfully completed.
2. Outstanding Performance in Annual examination by the students of National College of Education, Sirsa during the session 2023-24. Most of the students secured 70 % marks and above in both B.Ed. 1st and 2nd Year.
3. Ms. Kashish Khatter (Recommended) in Classical Vocal Solo in 11th Triveni Yuva Mahastav (Youth Festival) at Chaudhary Devi Lal University, Sirsa held from 15th to 19th November, 2024 and was selected for participation in 38th AIU Inter University North West Youth Festival held from 8th to 12th February, 2025.

Students participated in District level competition organized by District Election office, Sirsa on 25/1/2025 and team of Rupinder and Priya won first prize and Manju Bala and Parvinder Kaur second prize in Rangoli making competition with cash prize of Rs. 2500/- each and Rs. 1500/- each. Srishti won second prize and Harshika third prize in essay writing competition with cash prize of Rs. 1500/- and Rs. 1000/- respectively.

5. Students participated in Divisional Level Road Safety Competition organized by Additional Director General of Police Hissar Mandal held at Guru Gorakhnath Ji Government College in Hisar on 30.12.2024. The college team achieved second position.
